

# Funcionalidades

TikiWiki es un "sistema de gestión de contenido" (SGC o CMS, de sus siglas en inglés) lleno de funcionalidades — está tan repleto de funcionalidades que puede ser abrumador, incluso para un usuario experimentado o administrador. Por lo tanto, parece adecuado y útil dividir las funcionalidades de TikiWiki en estas categorías generales:

- **Herramientas del Sistema de Gestión de Contenidos** Estas características permiten a los administradores y usuarios crear, mostrar, y mantener contenido accesible por red de todo tipo, incluyendo texto, datos binarios, imágenes, enlaces, y mucho más.
- **Herramientas de organización del Contenido y Ayudas de Navegación** Estas funcionalidades permiten a las personas administradoras y usuarias organizar, estructurar, y presentar contenido de una forma navegable.
- **Herramientas de Comunicación** Estas funcionalidades permiten a las personas administradoras y usuarias comunicarse entre ellas (y con el mundo exterior) por medio de numerosos medios, incluyendo mensajería interna, telefonía de voz, intercambio de datos, y muchos más.
- **Herramientas de Administración** Estas funcionalidades permiten a personas administradoras (y a personas usuarias a quien se les ha asignado los permisos apropiados) administrar todos los aspectos de un sitio basado en Tikiwiki.

Charts	Like polls, but more feature-rich; displayed in center column
Comments	User comments that can be appended to articles, Wiki pages, forum posts, and more
Cookie	Taglines drawn randomly from tagline database
Directory	User-submitted Web links
Dynamic Content	Snippets of text or code that can be incorporated by reference
Ephemerides	Content that varies by date
FAQ	Frequently asked questions and answers
Featured Links	External Web pages that open in an iframe
File Gallery	Computer files and software for downloading
Forum	Online discussions on a variety of topics
HTML Pages	Static and dynamic HTML content
Image Gallery	Collections of graphic images for viewing or downloading
Map	Navigable, interactive maps with user-selectable layers
Newsletters	Content mailed to registered users
Polls	Brief list of votable options; appears in module (left or right column)
Quiz	Timed questionnaire with recorded scores
Feeds	Newsfeeds from external Web sites
Surveys	Questionnaire
Trackers	Facts and figures storage & retrieval
Wiki	Collaboratively authored documents

Calendar	Show when content was created or modified
Category	Classify content according to subject descriptors

<a href="#">Hotwords</a>	Automatically attach links to specified words or phrases.
<a href="#">Module</a>	Control appearance and content of boxes that appear in the left and right columns
<a href="#">MyTiki</a>	Provide content organization and communication tools for registered users
<a href="#">Search</a>	Provide full-text search capabilities
<a href="#">Structures</a>	Create hierarchically organized "breadcrumb" navigation aids for Wiki pages
<a href="#">UserMenu</a>	Create custom menus to aid site navigation
<a href="#">Workflow</a>	Control routing of documents based on objectively defined actions.

<a href="#">Chat</a>	Real-time text chatting
<a href="#">Communication Center</a>	Exchange data with other TikiWiki sites
<a href="#">Live Support</a>	Notify admin by e-mail when a user needs help.
<a href="#">Mail-In</a>	Submit Wiki pages via e-mail.
<a href="#">Messaging</a>	Enable users to send internal messages to each other
<a href="#">Mobile</a>	Make a TikiWiki site accessible to users of Web-enabled cell phones.
<a href="#">Shoutbox</a>	Provide a "graffiti" box on the site's home page.
<a href="#">Tikibot</a>	Respond to data queries originated via IRC.
<a href="#">Voice Tiki</a>	Provide voice-based browsing capability.
<a href="#">Webmail</a>	Give users Web-based access to their POP3 e-mail accounts

<a href="#">Admin Drawings</a>	Set up drawing tools for Wiki pages.
<a href="#">Admin DSN</a>	Create links to external databases.
<a href="#">Articles Admin Panel</a>	Configure Articles features.
<a href="#">Backup</a>	Make dumps of TikiWiki's SQL database.
<a href="#">Banners</a>	Insert, track, and manage advertising banners.
<a href="#">Banning</a>	Block access from individual IPs or ranges of IPs.
<a href="#">Blog Admin Panel</a>	Configure Blog features.
<a href="#">Link Cache</a>	Control and flush cached data.
<a href="#">Directory Admin Panel</a>	Configure Directory feature.
<a href="#">Edit Templates</a>	Edit SMARTY templates.
<a href="#">External Wikis</a>	Enable direct links to external Wikis.
<a href="#">FAQs Admin Panel</a>	Configure FAQ feature.
<a href="#">Features Admin Panel</a>	Enable or disable TikiWiki features.
<a href="#">File Galleries Admin Panel</a>	Configure <a href="#">File Gallery</a> feature.
<a href="#">Forums Admin Panel</a>	Configure Forum feature.
<a href="#">General Admin Panel</a>	Set up, name, and configure a TikiWiki site.
<a href="#">Groups</a>	Manage user groups.
<a href="#">Import PHPWiki</a>	Import data from a PHPWiki site.
<a href="#">Image Galleries Admin Panel</a>	Configure <a href="#">Image Gallery</a> feature.
<a href="#">Integrator</a>	Automatically import external HTML pages into the Wiki.
<a href="#">Login Admin Panel</a>	Control user login processes.

Maps Admin Panel	Configure Map feature.
<a href="#">Phpinfo</a>	View PHP information on the server.
Polls Admin Panel	Configure Polls feature.
<a href="#">Toolbar</a>	Define QuickTags for inserting Wiki syntax.
Referrer Stats	View referrer stats.

<a href="#">Search Stats</a>	View search stats.

<a href="#">Theme Control</a>	Assign different themes to various TikiWiki components.
