## Parameters

Displays the specified number of the directory sites most recently added.

*Preferences required:* `feature_directory`

Parameters	Accepted Values	Description	Default	Since
<code>absurl</code>		If set to "y", some of the links use an absolute URL instead of a relative one. This can avoid broken links if the module is to be sent in a newsletter, for example. Default: "n".		
<code>more</code>		If set to "y", displays a button labelled "More" that links to the directory. Not set by default.		
<code>categoryId</code>		If set to a directory category identifier, only displays the sites in the specified directory category. Not set by default.		
<code>maxdesc</code>	<code>int</code>	If <code>desc = "y"</code> , use <code>maxdesc</code> to set the maximum length of the directory site (in characters). Leave blank to set no maximum (show the entire description). Default: blank.		
<code>desc</code>	<code>word</code>	If set to "y", the description of the directory site appears. Default: "n".
