Categories are a feature of Tiki that allows to characterize Wiki pages, Trackers and other elements (which ?). You should not mix them with Keywords, another feature of Tiki that is less structured. This page contains mainly tables about Categories, including the relevan permissions, database structures, etc. Since some references are very old, it is probably obsolete to some extent.

# Permissions

This could provide a layer where categorated are only visible to a given group for internal management, while other groups won't even know there is a categories system.
