


# Improve TrackerÂ Forms

## Enable theÂ feature

You can enable the feature in:

**Admin home > Features > Interface (tab) > jQuery plugins and add-ons > Experimental > jQuery-ui Chosen Menu**





# Multiple selection

Similarly, a section to allow multiple selection of items can be shown in a small but enhanced dropdown box, which allows the user to select one or many of the options, remove them from the list in the text field at the top:
