

Module calendar_new

Introduced in version 3.0

This Module adds a small calendar that allows to see the events of the current month, basic data in the calendar box, and the other info on a hover box while passing the mouse over.

Parameters

Includes a calendar or a list of calendar events.

Preferences required: feature_calendar

Parameters	Accepted Values	Description	Default	Since
calIds		If set to a list of calendar identifiers, restricts the events to those in the identified calendars. Identifiers are separated by vertical bars (" "), commas (",") or colons (":"). Example values: "13", "4,7", "31:49". Not set by default.		
month_delta	int	Distance in month to the month to display. A distance of -1 would display the previous month. Setting this option implies a calendar view type with a month time span. Example values: 2, 0, -2, -12.		
viewmode	word	If in calendar (or "table") view type, determines the time span displayed by the calendar. Possible values: year, semester, quarter, month ,week, day. A user changing this time span in the calendar can change the time span the module displays for him.	month	
linkall	word	y n	n	
showaction	word	y n	y	
viewnavbar	word	y n partial	y	
viewlist	word	Determines how to show events. Possible values: table, list.	table	
viewmodelink	word	week day	week	

Usage

The assigned module looks like this:



If you change the main Tiki calendar view (for example, semester mode), the calendar module will be updated accordingly.

You can specify if you want to see the events in a popup for each day. The calendars are specified in the params box on the admin->modules page:

callds[] = 1 & callds[] = 2

To see the calendar 1 and the calendar 2

Be careful: permissions are not checked on the calendar
