EXAMPLE

This code will cause a pop-up dialog box to appear when this page is loaded:

Plugin

```
{DIALOG(title="World hello Dialog!" buttons="Foo,Bar" actions="alert(\"foo clicked\"),alert(\"you cancelled\")"
showAnim="blind" hideAnim="explode" autoOpen="y" modal="y" wiki="plugin dialog test body"
openAction="testDialog(this);")}Hello World{DIALOG}
```

EXAMPLE WITH SMARTY TEMPLATE

The following code will cause a popup dialog window.

Put this in at the end of your template file:

```
{wikipugin _name="DIALOG" autoOpen="n" id="wpdialog_bobshop_shipping" title="Shipping Costs" modal="y"
wiki="bobshop_shipping"}{/wikipugin}
```

Don't forget the underscore "_" before the parameter "_name".

Place this code in your template file at the place you want:

```
<p onClick='javascript:$( "#wpdialog_bobshop_shipping" ).dialog( "open" );'>Shipping</p>
```

In this example there must be a wikipage called "bobshop_shipping". Feel free to create it.
