

Plugin Superscript

Use this [wiki plugin](#) to render characters as superscript text. It is the equivalent of using `` tags in HTML.

PARAMETERS

Apply superscript font to text

Introduced in Tiki 2.

Preferences required: wikiplugin_sup

Parameters

(body of plugin) - text

no parameters

EXAMPLES

BASIC EXAMPLE

This code:

This is regular text{SUP()}and this is superscript{SUP}

Produces:

This is regular font^{and this is superscript}

EXAMPLE WITH FORMATTED SUPERSCRIPIT

This code,

This is regular text{SUP()}*"and this is italic superscript"*{SUP}

Produces:

This is regular text^{*and this is italic superscript*}



Tip

To use superscript footnote numbers, consider using [PluginFootnote](#) and [PluginFootnotearea](#), which work together to create and display automatically numbered footnotes.
