

There are many caches in Tiki to improve [Performance](#):

- [Smarty Cache](#)
- [Link Cache](#)
- [Cache External Images](#)
- Wiki Cache (for anonymous visitors, to avoid parsing page again & again)
- Data cache
 - [Memcached](#) when configured,
 - or defaults to filesystem cache
- Opcode/Bytecode offered by PHP
- MySQL also caches queries to improve performance
