Reference attributes

Biblio Code A unique reference code per page. Used to link the in-page reference to the bibliography listing

Author The author(s) of the work

Title The title of the work

Year The year, season, etc. the work was created/published

Part Part of the work referenced, e.g. page numbers

URI A Link to the work

Code Code identifying the work, e.g. the ISBN number

Style Formatting style. See below for details

Template Formatting layout. Determines which fields to display, the ordering and more

~author~	Name of the author(s)
~title~	The title of the referenced work
~year~	Publication year, date, season, etc.
~part~	The part of the work referenced, e.g. pages 180-185
~uri~	URI to the referenced work
~code~	Code, e.g. ISBN, of the referenced work
~publisher~	The company or unit that published the work
~location~	The place, e.g. city, where the work was published
