

## Plugin Mono

Use this [wiki plugin](#) to display text in a monospace font. By default, the monospace font specified by the browser is displayed, but another monospace font recognized by the browser may be used as well.

## Parameters

Display text in a monospace font

<code>font</code>	text	Font name as recognized by browsers.	monospace	1

## Examples

### No Font Parameter

*This code,*

---

```
{MONO()}This is the browser's default monospace font.{MONO}
```

*Would produce:*

This is the browser's default monospace font.

### With Font Parameter Set

*This code,*

---

```
{MONO(font="Lucida Console")}{MONO}This is the monospace font called Lucida Console.{MONO}
```

*Would produce this:*

This is the monospace font called Lucida Console.
