

# Plugin Superscript

Use this [wiki plugin](#) to render characters as superscript text. It is the equivalent of using `<sup></sup>` tags in HTML.

## Parameters

Apply superscript font to text

*Preferences required:* `wikiplugin_sup`

### Parameters

*(body of plugin)* - text

*no parameters*

## Examples

### Basic Example

*This code:*

```
This is regular text{SUP()}and this is superscript{SUP}
```

*Produces:*

This is regular font<sup>and this is superscript</sup>

### Example with Formatted Superscript

*This code,*

```
This is regular text{SUP()} "and this is italic superscript" {SUP}
```

*Produces:*

This is regular text<sup>and this is italic superscript</sup>
