Preferences required: `wikiplugin_trackeritemcopy`, `feature_trackers`

Parameters	Accepted Values	Description	Default	Since
<b>copyFieldIds</b>	text <i>separator:</i>   :	Field IDs to copy old value of, separated by :, joined fields separated by		7.0
<b>linkFieldIds</b>	text <i>separator:</i> :	Fields links that are related to this tracker that you would like to join on, separated by :		8.0
<b>trackerId</b>	text <i>separator:</i> :	Tracker from which to copy item, joined tracker ids separated by :		7.0
<b>copies_on_load</b>	int	Set the number of copies to make on load of plugin automatically		7.0
<b>itemId</b>	text	ID of item to make copy of, otherwise input is asked for		7.0
<b>return_array</b>	text	If Yes (y), returns array of new information instead of displaying results to screen, used in non-interactive mode		7.0

<code>updateFieldValues</code>	text	New values to replace for the field IDs specified, separated by <code>:</code> , joined fields separated by <code> </code> . <code>randomstring</code> will generate random string; and <code>f_xx</code> to use value of field xx of itemId	7.0
<code>updateFieldIds</code>	text	Field IDs to update with new values specified, separated by <code>:</code> , joined fields separated by <code> </code>	7.0

Note: Will not work with category or certain special fields, copies only data from specified fields.
